




**Malawi Celebrates ISO 15189 Accreditation of Laboratories** 



Ciheb, in conjunction with the Malawi Ministry of Health and other partners, held an awards ceremony to celebrate the ISO 15189:2012 medical laboratory accreditation of six facilities, four of which were supported by Ciheb. The accreditations, given by the Southern African Development Community Accreditation Service (SADCAS), marks the first time these international standards have been achieved in Malawi.



## Public Health Impact through Research in HIV and TB in Western Kenya



Maintaining Kenya's remarkable strides towards reaching the UNAIDS 95-95-95 targets requires concerted efforts between the government and its partners to ensure the sustainability of successful interventions, as well as the exploration of new evidence-based public health strategies informed by evaluations, surveillance, and research.

In 2016, the University of Maryland, Baltimore (UMB) through Ciheb partnered with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention to implement a new five-year program called "Technical Assistance for Public Health Impact in Kenya" (TAPHIK).
