Ciheb Nigeria is assisting a Cohort Event Monitoring (CEM) survey to examine and evaluate the safety of individuals following COVID-19 vaccinations in Nigeria in the five states of Bauchi, Edo, Enugu, Kaduna, Lagos, and the Federal Capital Territory, Abuja. This observational surveillance program's purpose is to monitor safety signal detection following the rollout of COVID-19 vaccines in the country.
